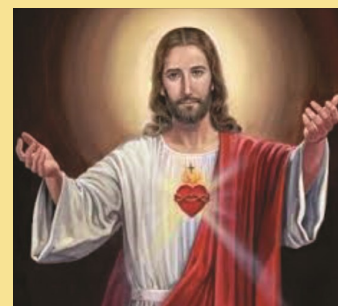




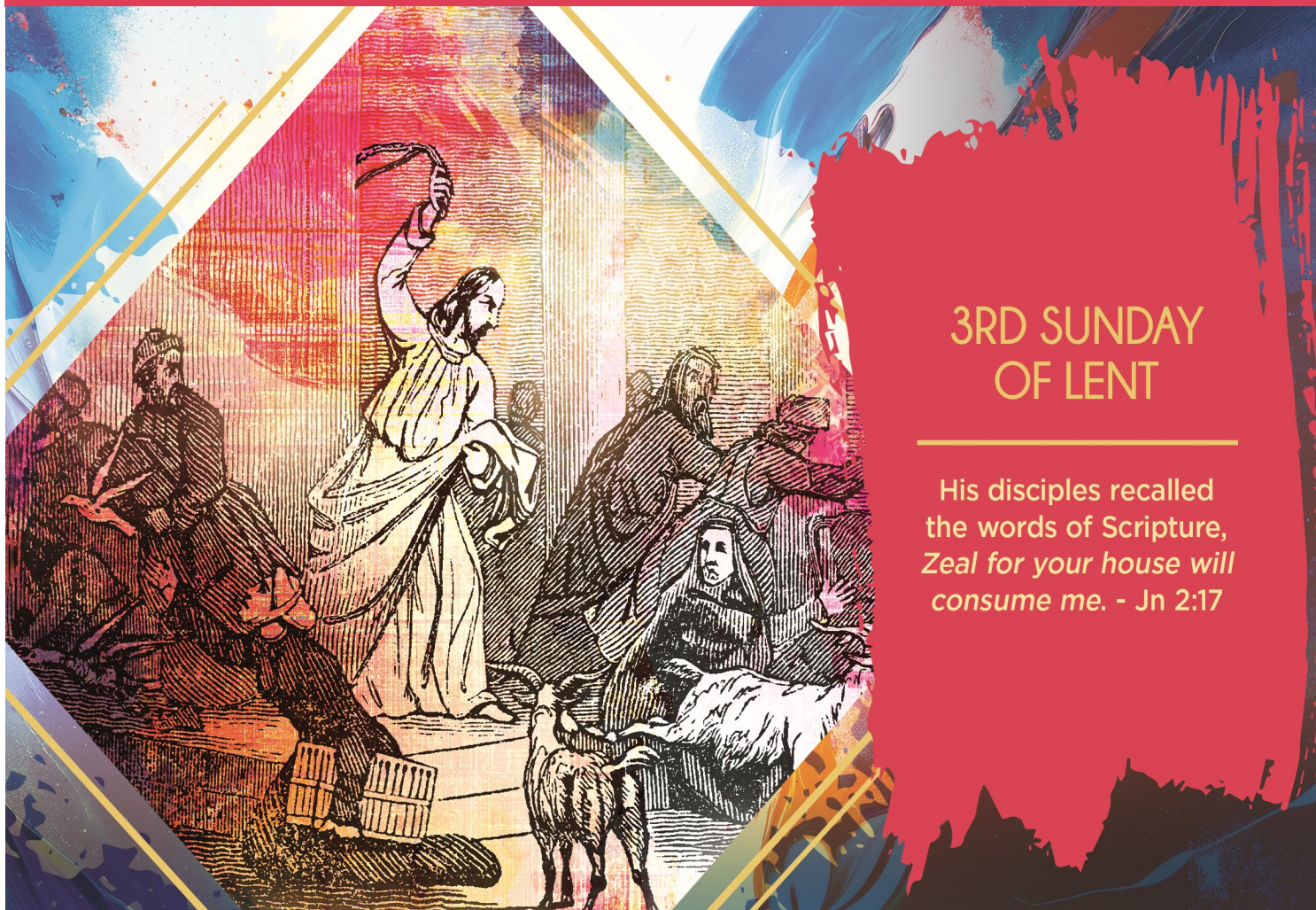

## SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

The Diocese requires all volunteers to have a criminal background check and to watch a video on "Safe Environment." Both are available on the VIRTUS website. You need only watch the video training one time; but the background check needs renewed every three years. Results from the background check are not revealed to the Parish Staff; but, if there is something that may keep you from working with children, the Diocesan Safe Environment Office will contact Father Thomas directly.

## LENTEN DINNER

### IDEA:

### TUSCAN PORTABELLO STEW

### INGREDIENTS

2 Large Portobello Mushrooms  
1 Medium Onion, Chopped  
3 Garlic Cloves, Minced  
2 Tablespoons Olive Oil  
1/2 Cup White Wine or Vegetable Broth  
1 Can (28 oz) Diced Tomatoes, Undrained

2 Cups Chopped Fresh Kale  
1 Bay Leaf  
1 Teaspoon Dried Thyme  
1/2 Teaspoon Dried Basil  
1/2 Teaspoon Dried Rosemary, Crushed  
1/4 Teaspoon Salt  
1/4 Teaspoon Pepper  
2 Cans (15 oz each) Cannellini Beans, rinsed and drained

### DIRECTIONS

- 1.) In a large skillet; saute the mushrooms, onion, and garlic in oil until tender. Add wine: Bring to a boil, cook until liquid is reduced by half. Stir in tomatoes, kale, and seasonings: Bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 8-10 minutes.
- 2.) Add beans; heat through: Discard bay leaf.
