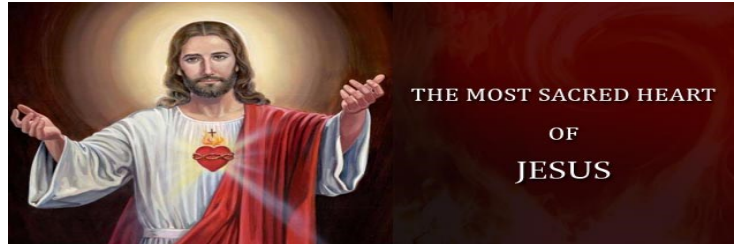

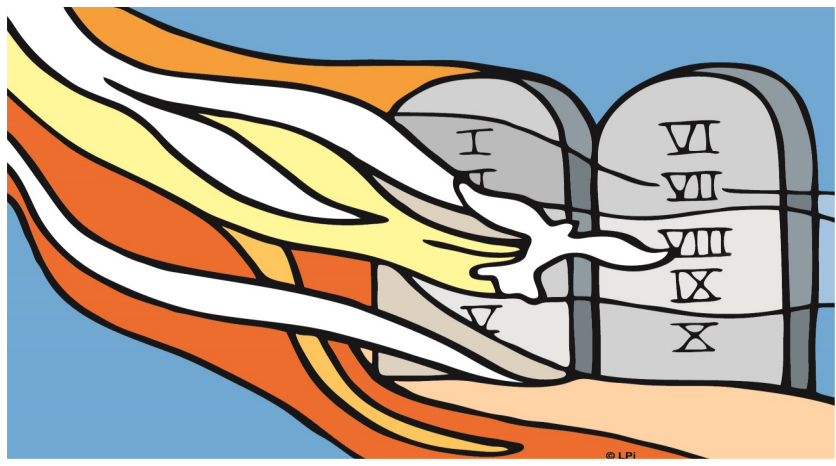

PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

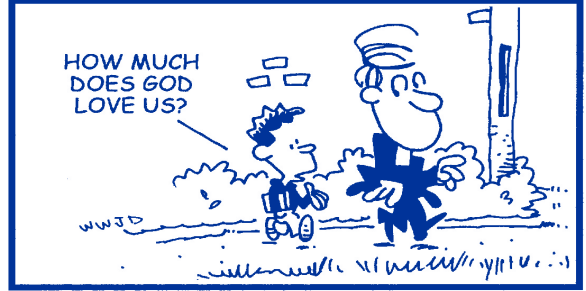
