



Please notify Fr. Thomas prior to surgery or in times of illness. Also, please notify us when a parishioner is in the hospital, nursing home, or is homebound.




PARISH MISSION STATEMENT



the background check needs renewed every three years. Results from the background check are not revealed to the Parish Staff; but, if there is something that may keep you from working with children, the Diocesan Safe Environment Office will contact Father Thomas directly.
