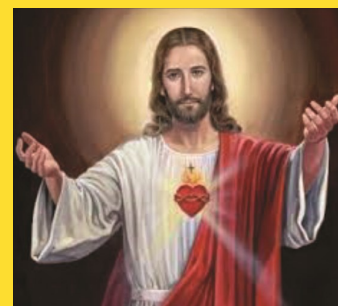


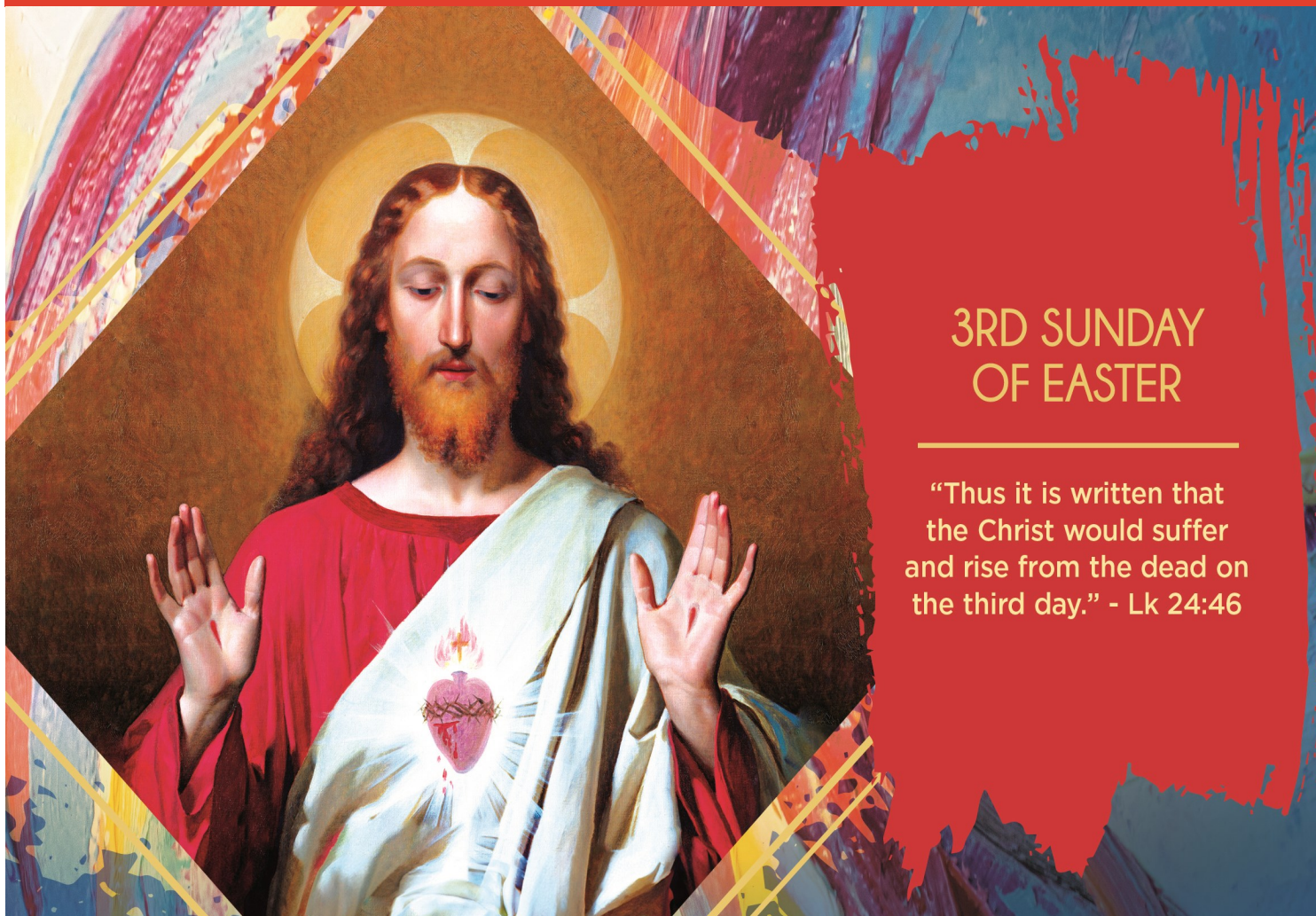

PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

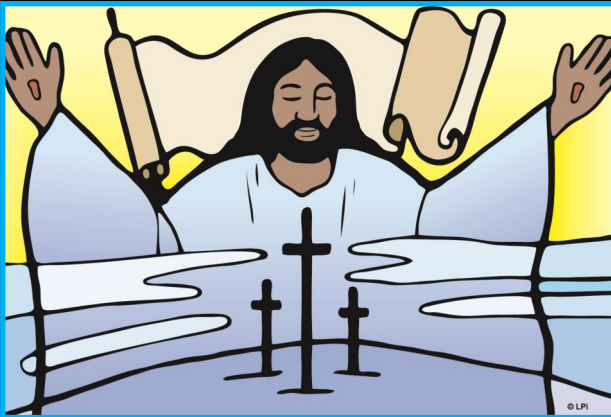

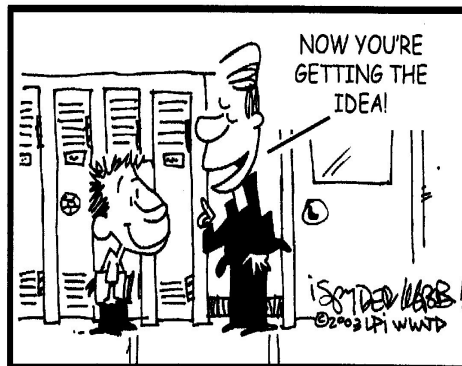
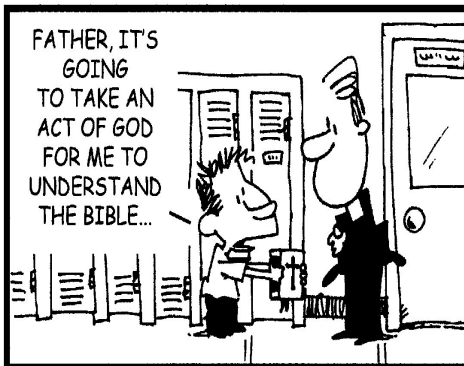
