SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

The Diocese requires all volunteers to have a criminal background check and to watch a video on "Safe Environment." Both are available on the VIRTUS website. You need only watch the video training one time; but the background check needs renewed every three years. Results from the background check are not revealed to the Parish Staff; but, if there is something that may keep you from working with children, the Diocesan Safe Environment Office will contact Father Thomas directly.

If this is your first time to complete Virtus, please go to www.virtusonline.org to fill out the form and view the video. Click on "First Time Applicant" and the program will direct you from there.
